Compiling C++ Source Files

In this class, we will be using the g++ compiler from the Linux command-line in Sleipnir. Here are two options that will allow you to compile your source code into an executable binary file.

Option 1

Step 1 - Using a sample filename called sample1.cpp

Step 2 – Your source file will be compiled into a file called **a.out**. Run this file as shown below:
